Queen Elizabeth's School a brief history

QE is a school with a proud history of serving Crediton and the surrounding villages that stretches back over four hundred and seventy years, originally as a grammar school, then as a boarding grammar for boys and girls. We are now a fully inclusive comprehensive school for students aged 11 - 18.

We have two separate sites, or campuses. The Barnfield campus, with its beautiful grounds and views right across the hills to Dartmoor, is the former Shelley School and houses years 7 and 8. The smaller scale and the open spaces allow our younger students to flourish in a safe and caring environment.

The Western Road campus houses years 9 to 13 in an eclectic mix of impressive and well-resourced buildings that includes the grade II listed College House, which is now our Sixth Form centre, and the red-brick West Wing originally opened in 1910 as the High School for Girls.
